



**Water Works of Art:  
Pinellas Public Library Cooperative's Amateur Photography Contest  
Summer 2010**

**Agreement Form and Contest Rules and Regulations**

This contest is open to amateurs only. A professional is defined as one whose primary source of income (50% or more) results from his/her photographic work. The theme of the contest is water. Every entry must have water in the photograph.

Only Pinellas County residents are eligible to enter the contest. No employees or their immediate family members of any member library of the Pinellas Public Library Cooperative (PPLC) are eligible to enter the contest.

There will be three categories: children (up to age 12), teens (13-19), and adults (20 and up). Prizes will be awarded in each category as follows:

First prize: \$75

Second prize: \$50

Third prize: \$25

Honorable Mention: ribbon

Submissions will be accepted via e-mail from June 14 until July 17, 2010. Limit is one (1) submission per person. Submissions of more than one photograph will be disqualified. Submissions should be e-mailed to: [WaterWorksofArt@gmail.com](mailto:WaterWorksofArt@gmail.com). The subject of the email should be: *photo contest* and the appropriate age category. The body of the e-mail must include the contestant's name, address, and phone number. Submissions should be in JPEG format and at least 1 MB in size.

All submissions belong to the Pinellas Public Library Cooperative. If a photograph is deemed inappropriate, it will not be entered into the contest. All accepted contest entries will be displayed on the Water Works of Art Flickr account.

Photographs selected for the contest will be judged from July 18 through July 24, 2010. The judges' decisions are final.

Contest winners will be announced at the Largo Public Library during a reception on Saturday, July 31, 2010. Refreshments will be provided. Selected photographs will comprise a traveling exhibit throughout Pinellas County. It will begin at the Largo Public Library's art gallery from August 1-August 31, 2010. The exhibit will be at Clearwater Main Library the month of September. Please check with your library for the complete schedule.
