## National Braille Literacy Month

January is National Braille Literacy month to honor the birthday of Louis Braille (January 4th, 1809). At age 12, Louis Braille invented a system of reading and writing for the Blind and visually impaired, which still used today. Over the years, Braille has had a positive impact on the literacy and communication skills of those who are Blind or visually impaired. The National Federation for the Blind (NFB) estimates that 10% of students with a visual disability are being taught to read Braille. Many Blind or visually impaired children and their families choose to rely on audio books and materials for their literacy and communication skills. The National Braille Literacy month was created to raise awareness of the importance of Braille to the Blind and visually impaired community.

One stigma surrounding Braille is that as technology progresses and

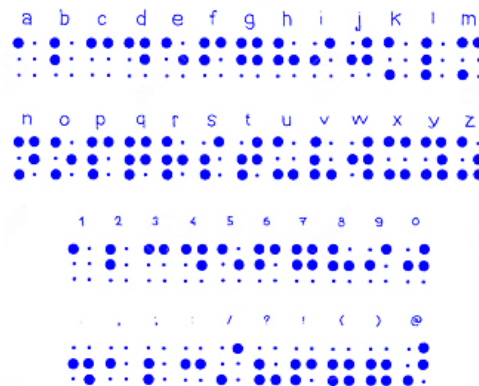
materials such as audiobooks and voice-command are readily available, there is less need for Blind and low vision children to learn Braille. Braille is important in many environments for the Blind and visually impaired such as school and the workplace, just like pen and paper.

The Pinellas Talking Book Library (PTBL) serves the Blind, vision impaired, and reading impaired residents of Pinellas and Sarasota Counties. The PTBL offers books and magazines in both audio and Braille, because both audial and Braille literacy are valuable resources.

Helping to raise awareness for Braille literacy is not for just the Blind or visually impaired, but for everyone! There are several ways to get involved during the National Braille Literacy month. Reach out to someone who is Blind or has a visual impairment, ask them about Braille and if they would

want to teach you how to read it. Perhaps you want to learn in order to support a friend or loved one who

uses Braille or are simply curious about the process of Braille writing. Learning to read Braille is a great New Year's Resolution for everyone. For teachers and educators, look for a way to incorporate Braille into your lesson plans. Exposure to Braille can make a difference in the lives of sighted and Blind or visually impaired students alike. Be sure to check out the Perkins School for the Blind YouTube channel, and connect with the American Foundation for the Blind to find out more ways to raise awareness.
