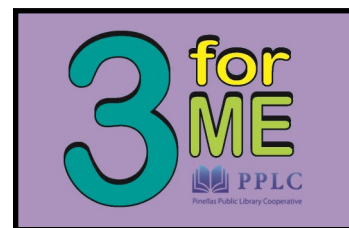


Museum Pass Program

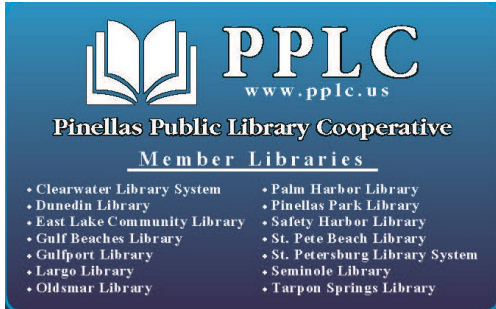
